- The student has been accepted and plans to attend an agriculture or agriculture-related program of study in a post-secondary school.
- The immediate family (Parents/guardians) holds membership in good standing in Georgetown County Farm Bureau.

The basic scholarship amount is \$1000.00. It is a one-time award.

First consideration will be given to a rising college freshman. If there is no applicant from that group, an upperclassman may be considered for the scholarship.

Applications are available at the Georgetown County Farm Bureau office and on the Georgetown County Farm Bureau webpage. Applications will also be placed in the guidance offices at each Georgetown County high school.
