AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP: \$3,000

The purpose of the Scholarship Award Program is to provide scholarship assistance to young people of our county's farm families or from farm-oriented background, to pursue a higher education in agriculture or agricultural related major. It is also desired that this scholarship will result in the encouragement of young people to develop the knowledge and skills to assume positions of leadership.

This scholarship will be awarded to a college sophomore, junior, or senior pursuing a degree in agriculture related major. One half of the scholarship will be credited the first semester and the remaining one half at the beginning of the second semester; or will be handled in a manner acceptable to the educational institution involved. Incomplete applications will not be considered (including photo).

This scholarship will be awarded to a resident of Anderson County based on character, demonstrated leadership abilities, and dedication to agriculture or related field. The recipient will be selected by the Scholarship Committee of the SC Farm Bureau Foundation in accordance with guidelines developed by the foundation's board of directors and approved by the foundation membership.

The current scholarship application judging guidelines are:

- Scholastic achievement in college---35 points
- Agricultural activities, participation and offices held in school and agricultural organizations, and community activities-25 points
- Students statement and focus on career in agriculture or agricultural related Field-30 points
- Letter(s) of recommendation, which should include character references-10 points


