- 1. Applicants must be a resident of Pickens County and a member of Pickens County Farm Bureau. (This includes students under their parent's membership.) Membership is \$40.00 per year.
- 2. Applicant must show agricultural involvement. (Ex. Working on a farm, member of Future Farmers of America or the 4-H Club, etc.)
- 3. Applicant age limit is 18 to 22 years of age.
- 4. Application is for undergraduate degrees only.

5. Attach to this application the following:

- a. Copy of High School or College transcript
- b. Copy of acceptance letter from college (if available)
- c. Letter of recommendation from a high school principal, guidance counselor, or one teacher.
- d. Letter of reference from employer, pastor, or other community leader.
- e. Copy of recent photograph.

Applicants must be enrolled in college or technical school by January of the year following graduation.
