- The student has been accepted and plans to attend an agriculture or agriculture-related program of study in a post-secondary school.
- The immediate family (Parents/guardians) or the student holds membership in good standing in Georgetown County Farm Bureau.

The basic scholarship amount is \$1000.00. It is a one-time award.

Consideration will be given to renewing the basic award for each subsequent year of higher education up to four years. Application, including college transcript, will be required each year.

Applications are available at the Georgetown County Farm Bureau office. Applications will also be placed in the guidance offices at each Georgetown County high school.
