

The Marion County Farm Bureau Scholarship Awards

The Marion County Farm Bureau will directly fund two \$1000.00 scholarships to a college student whose intent is to pursue a four-year degree, with no restriction on the field of study. The Marion County Farm Bureau will also directly fund one \$500 scholarship to a college student whose intent is to pursue a two-year degree, with no restriction on the field of study. The applicant must be a current member of the Marion County Farm Bureau or the child of an active Marion County Farm Bureau member. Once received, the applications will be reviewed and ranked by a scholarship committee. Applications will be ranked with emphasis on the following areas: 1) scholastic achievement, 2) financial need and 3) agricultural background and related activities.

Scholarship Schedule

Completed applications due to the Marion County Farm Bureau Office by August 15.

The scholarship winner(s) will be recognized during the Marion County Farm Bureau Annual Meeting in the fall.
